

SNAP BENEFITS

What is SNAP?

SNAP is the supplemental nutrition assistance program, commonly known as food stamps. SNAP is the largest anti-hunger program in the United States. The USDA sets the standards and provides funding, and the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) administers the program.

Who is eligible for SNAP?

- US citizens or individuals with specific immigration status
- Individuals who meet an income below 130% poverty level; households with seniors or disabled individuals have higher limits

Ultimately, a client is determined eligible by OKDHS staff. In Oklahoma SNAP eligibility is determined mostly by income per household. Work requirements are also considered.

Where can I use my SNAP benefits?

Major grocery stores and most convenience stores

What can I purchase with my SNAP benefits?

- Fruits/vegetables
- Protein: meat, fish, poultry
- Dairy
- Bread
- Baked goods
- Legumes
- · Jams, honey, sauces
- Soups
- Food producing plants and seeds

What am I not able to purchase?

- Hot foods or items eaten on-site
- Alcohol
- Tobacco products
- Non-food items

WIC BENEFITS

What is WIC?

WIC is a supplemental nutrition program for women, infants, and children that provides nutritional foods, nutrition counseling and education, and referrals to healthcare and social services.

Who is eligible for WIC?

- Women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or have recently given birth; infants and children up to the age of five
- The applicant must be a resident of the state of Oklahoma
- The applicant must meet income requirements; if receiving Medicaid, SNAP, or TANF, individuals are automatically eligible for WIC benefits

How can I apply for WIC?

- Apply online at www.ok.gov/health under the Family Health tab, or call a WIC clinic near you to schedule an appointment
- Have proof of identification, income and address available

What can I purchase with my WIC benefits?

- Infant formula, baby food
- Infant and adult cereal
- Fruits/vegetables
- Protein: meats, eggs, peanut butter, canned fish, tofu
- Grains: whole wheat bread, brown rice, soft/corn/ whole wheat tortillas
- Juice, soy beverage
- Dairy: milk, cheese
- Dried beans or peas
