

LEXINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Child Nutrition and other close community resources: Our child nutrition department will continue serving basic meal items to children from 1 to 18 years of age (or enrolled 19 year olds) who want or need it. A sacked selection of a breakfast and lunch item will be available at three locations daily, during the current closure, except for Friday April 3rd when we would have been closed per our school calendar. These locations and times are by drive-thru pickup at the Elementary School from 10 am to 11:30 am, Lexington Rural Fire station # 2 near the 144th and Hwy 39 intersection from 10 am to 11 am, and the corner of Slaughterville Road and Highway 77 near Slaughterville Town Hall from 10 am to 11 am. Look for the school bus. Students must be present. Food items cannot be given to adults without their eligible children present. A limited number of meals will be prepped for the outer locations. If you arrive and are not served please come by the Elementary school drive thru.

As a reminder regarding other available community resources, the Chickasaw Nation Nutrition Center at 1530 Hardcastle Blvd., Purcell, OK currently has shelf stable meals available to all children age 1 to age 18 during the hours of 10:00 am to 5 pm. Child must be present.

Looking forward, please be reminded that the Nation's EBT program begins May 15th and will provide for the nutritional summer needs of any student who qualifies. Applications are available at the Nutrition office cited above.

Meal service beginning March 23 for both drive thru and mobile locations:

- Purcell Elementary School - 809 N. 9th Street
- Drive-thru option only. Pick up is outside kitchen, parents should pull through bus lane on south side of elementary building.
- Hours of operation will be 9-11 a.m. We will be serving you both a breakfast sack and a lunch sack at this time.

Mobile locations where meals will be available:

- Be at one of the designated locations between 9:15-9:45 a.m.
- Hallmark Mobile Home Park, Hallmark Blvd and Hallmark Avenue
- Conger Field, N. 2nd Avenue & West Van Buren Street
- McCurdy Park, West Washington & North 6th Avenue
- Purcell Jr. High, West Apache and Lester Lane
- Headstart, Lester Lane and West Fox Street
- McClain County Expo Center, Hardcastle Blvd & Phillips Street
- Stonewall Plaza Apartments, Southway Avenue and Hwy 74)
- Southway Mobile Home Park, Whippoorwill Drive & Elliot Drive
- Purcell Mobile Home Park, Mantooth Drive & S. 9th Street

Please stay in the vehicle or if you walk to the location maintain at least six feet between families to practice social distancing.

Meals will be dispersed from the back door of the bus.

You will receive both a breakfast sack and a lunch sack at this time.

No Identification required for either option, but children must be present to receive meals.
